between September 15, 2020 and January 23, 2023
inclusive (the “Class”), you may be affected by a
class action lawsuit that is currently pending.**

What Has Happened So Far? Various entities that acquired Alphabet Class A and/or Class C shares have sued Alphabet, Google LLC, and Sundar Pichai (“Defendants”) for violations of federal securities laws, alleging a false and misleading statement about how Google’s advertising technology products worked. This is an action for violations of Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 promulgated thereunder and Section 20(a) of the Exchange Act. The Defendants deny that any of the Defendants made any false or misleading statements regarding advertising technology products. The United States District Court for the Northern District of California (the “Court”) has not made any determinations about whether the Defendants engaged in any alleged misconduct or wrongdoing. The Class Period is September 15, 2020 to January 23, 2023, both dates inclusive. This Notice is issued pursuant to Rule 23 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and an Order of the Court, entered on May 18, 2026, certifying the above action as a Class Action. **The Court has not ruled on the merits of Class Representatives’ claims or on Defendants’ denials or other defenses.**

Who Is Included? If you purchased or otherwise acquired Alphabet Class A and/or Class C shares during the Class Period, you may be a member of the Class. If you purchased or otherwise acquired Alphabet Class A and/or Class C shares during the Class Period for the beneficial interest of a Class member, you are required to forward this notice to the beneficial owners of shares or provide their contact information to the Notice Administrator, *Alphabet Securities Litigation*, PO Box 6018, Portland, OR 97228-6018, or info@AlphabetSecuritiesLitigation.com. As is explained in the full Notice, certain persons and entities (including Defendants, their families, and the officers, directors, and affiliates of Alphabet at all relevant times) are excluded from the Classes by definition.

Who Represents Me? The Court has appointed attorneys at Pomerantz LLP as Class Counsel to represent the Class on a contingent fee basis. You may hire your own lawyer to represent you at your own expense. Plaintiffs Menora Mivtachim Insurance Ltd., Menora Mivtachim Pensions and Gemel Ltd., AMI - Government Employees Provident Fund Management Company Ltd., and City of Fort Lauderdale Police & Fire Retirement System are Class members, and the Court has appointed them to serve as “Class Representatives.”

What Are My Rights & Options? You have a choice of whether to stay in the Class or to exclude yourself from it by **September 16, 2026**. If you do nothing, you are choosing to stay in the Class, and are allowing the Court-appointed Class Counsel and the Class Representatives to continue to represent you and the Class and move forward with the lawsuit on your behalf. If the case settles or the Court enters a judgment in favor of the Plaintiffs, you will get the benefit of that settlement or judgment. If you do nothing, you will remain in the lawsuit and cannot bring your own case against the Defendants for the legal claims included in this lawsuit. If you choose to exclude yourself, you will not be entitled to recover monetary benefits from the Plaintiffs’ efforts, but you will be entitled to pursue any individual remedy which you may have at your own expense. To ask to be excluded, send a letter to the return address **postmarked by September 16, 2026**, stating you want to be excluded from *AMI - Government Employees Provident Fund Management Company Ltd. v. Alphabet Inc., et al.*, No. 23-cv-01186 (N.D. Cal.) Include your name, address, telephone number, and signature, as well as the total number of Alphabet Class A and/or Class C shares purchased or acquired and the date the shares were purchased or acquired.

Your Other Rights. Class members are represented by Class Counsel. You will not be personally responsible for counsel’s fees and expenses. You may also hire your own attorney, at your own expense. If you do, your attorney must file a notice of appearance with the Court.
